

Mayo Neurosurgery Scholarship

Scholarship Details

The Mayo Neurosurgery Scholarship is a \$1,666 award that will be granted to 6 students per year who show promise for a future career in neurosurgery through their consistent attendance at our combined Howard-Mayo bi-weekly journal club. The purpose of the scholarship is to assist with the numerous costs associated with attending a national neurosurgery conference (i.e., registration, travel, lodging, food) so that these are not obstacles hindering students from taking part in such valuable educational and networking opportunities.

Requirements and Eligibility

- Must attend a journal club participating institution:
 - Howard University College of Medicine
 - Mayo Clinic School of Medicine
 - Meharry Medical College
 - Morehouse School of Medicine
- Must attend at least 80% of journal club sessions (equates to 15 sessions) over the course of the academic year
- Must present at 1 journal club meeting
- Must complete any surveys sent out
- Scholarship must be used to attend a national neurosurgery conference (i.e., CNS, NASS, AANS, etc.)
- Must attend Mayo Clinic Alumni Neurosurgery gathering (dinner reception hosted at each of the national meetings)

Recommendations

- Turn on camera and actively participate in journal club meetings
- Be a presenter at the national meeting interested in attending

Journal Club Details

The Howard-Mayo Neurosurgery Journal Club and Case Conference was established with the mission to expose and engage HBCU students to the field of neurosurgery. We have scholarly discussions on a variety of topics in neurosurgery and promote networking across the participating institutions. We hope the knowledge gained during these sessions can be used to prepare students to perform well during sub-internships and offset the steep learning curve at the start of residency.
